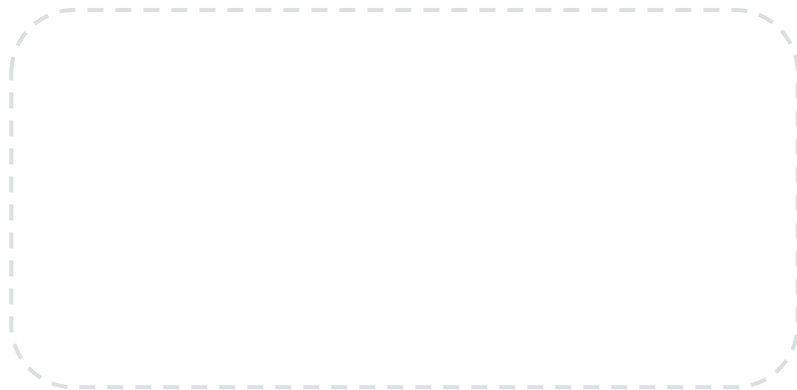

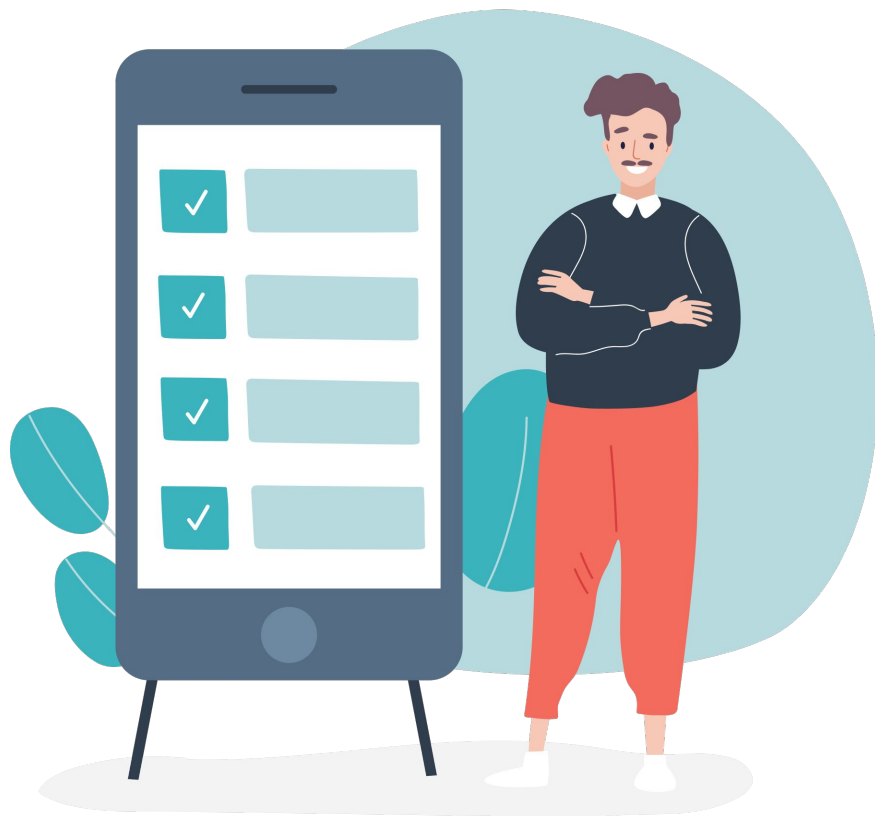

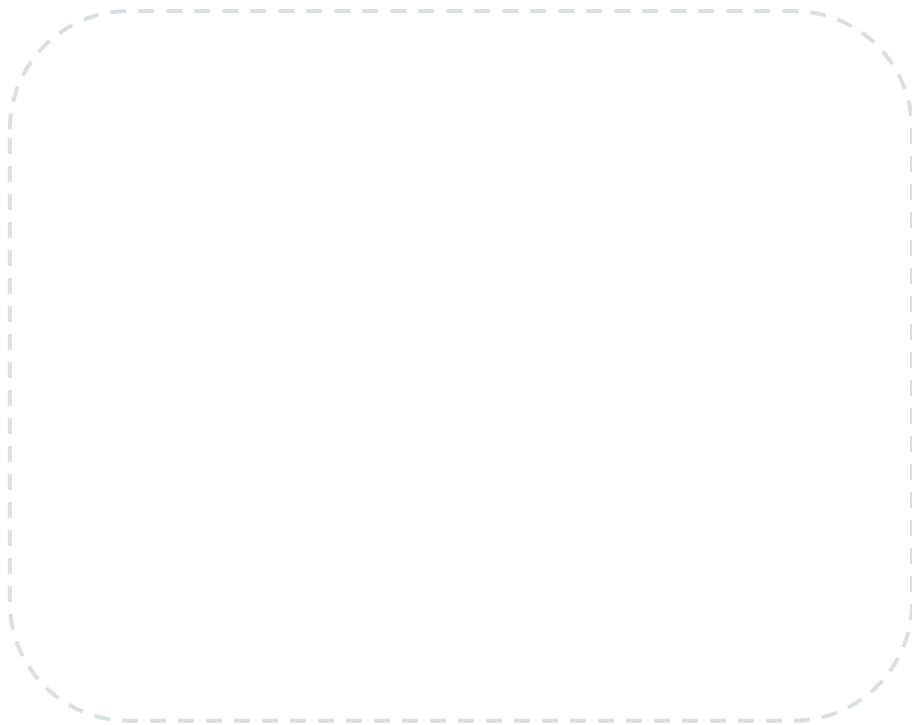

Grammar presentation: Can for ability

You can use the verb *can* to say that you can do something.

Person + *can* / *can't* + verb

***Can* + person + verb?**

For example:

- *I **can** understand you.*
- *I **can't** speak Spanish well.*
- *I **can** study on Monday.*
- *I **can't** study on Tuesday.*
- ***Can** she play the piano?*
- ***Can** they drive a car?*

Be careful!

✗ I can speaking English. **✓** I can speak English.

✗ My tutor can to help me. **✓** My tutor can help me.

✗ Can help you me? **✓** Can you help me?
